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Information and Registration Night at Badin set for Thursday, Jan. 28

Information and Registration Night for prospective members of the Class of 2014 at Badin High School is scheduled for Thursday, Jan. 28, from 6 p.m. to 8:15 p.m.

“We hope students will take the opportunity to register on this particular night,” said Principal Frank Margello. “Having this important decision out of the way is a big relief for students, families and all involved.”

The Information session will take place from 6 to 6:45 p.m. in Badin’s Little Theatre. Actual registration is scheduled from 6:45 to 8:15 p.m. In order to register, families should bring a copy of their child’s birth certificate and a check for \$300.

This non-refundable \$300 fee is part of the 2010-2011 tuition cost and is not an additional charge. Tuition for the next school year is \$7,500 for parish-affiliated students and \$7,700 for those who are not parish-affiliated.

Margello pointed out that in the past, Badin had held separate Information and Registration nights, but combined the two last year following a snow day.

“It worked out very well and we decided to keep it as one event,” Margello explained. “We received a lot of positive feedback from families who appreciated the fact that they only had to mark one night on their calendar as opposed to two in the midst of their very busy schedules.”

Students may register at Badin throughout the spring and summer, but doing it on Jan. 28 is important for scheduling purposes and other preparation concerns.

“It’s always an exciting night when families and student see each other and know that they are going to be a part of the Badin community,” Margello said. “All of us really enjoy seeing a new class start to come together.”

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
