Badin's Milillo, Reimer ink D-I women's soccer scholarships

Badin High School seniors Abby Milillo and Megan Reimer have inked scholarships to play Division I women's soccer in the fall.

Milillo, the daughter of Steve and Gail Milillo of Fairfield and a graduate of St. Ann School, will attend Ball State University in Muncie, Ind.

Reimer, the daughter of Bob and Linda Reimer of Hamilton and a graduate of St. Peter in Chains School, will attend Gardner Webb University in Boiling Springs, N.C.

"These girls have worked hard and are reaping the benefits of their outstanding play and our outstanding program," said Sally Kocher, Badin athletic director. "We know that they will play well in college and be a credit to their teams and their schools."

Reimer was named all-Greater Cincinnati as a midfielder for the Rams, who reached the Division II state finals for the third straight year under head coach Keith Haring before bowing to Shaker Heights Hathaway Brown 2-0 in the title game at Columbus Crew Stadium.

Milillo missed her senior season due to a knee injury, but had committed to Ball State in the spring based on her excellent play over three previous years on varsity. She was also an all-Ohio academic selection.

Milillo joins former BHS teammate Kristina Anderson, who is completing her freshman year, on the Ball State squad.

"Megan and Abby are to be congratulated for their success all across the board," said Badin Principal Frank Margello. "They've earned many honors over the years and we know they have a lot of big things ahead of them."
