Badin will combine Information and Registration nights on Thursday, Feb. 5

Badin High School will hold a combined Information and Registration night for potential incoming members of the Class of 2013 on Thursday, Feb. 5, starting at 6 o'clock.

"This seemed like the best way to solve a complicated situation due to the weather," said Principal Frank Margello, referring to last week's snow-related cancellation of the regular Information Night. "We believe we can effectively answer questions and prepare incoming families for registration at the same time."

Information Night will take place from 6 p.m. to 6:45 p.m. in the Little Theatre. Academic Dean Teresa Heinrich and others will give an overview of scheduling and other important issues for potential freshmen.

Registration will take place from 6:45 p.m. until 8:45 p.m. Families who come to Information Night are not obligated to register at that time; and families are not required to attend Information Night in order to register.

"They are really separate events, which is why we typically hold them a week apart," Margello explained. "It is our hope, certainly, that families who come to Information Night do in fact want to register their incoming freshmen and will do so that night."

Families are asked to bring a copy of their child's birth certificate for registration purposes. A non-refundable fee of \$300 is also required to register, but this fee is a part of the regular tuition cost and is not an additional charge.

"Registration Night is important because we need to get a count of our incoming freshmen for scheduling purposes," Margello noted. "We welcome students to register after that date, but we really encourage incoming freshmen to register on Thursday."
