### Badin, Fenwick set 'Volley for the Cure' girls' volleyball match Sept. 24 at Badin

Pink is the color and cancer is the cause as Badin and Fenwick high schools meet on the girls' volleyball court in the annual Volley for the Cure match, set this year for Thursday, Sept. 24, at Badin High School's Mulcahey Gym.

Badin Athletic Director Sally Kocher called it "a big night for an important cause."

Donations will go toward the Maureen Fritsch Cancer Assistance Fund as well as the Susan G. Komen for the Cure breast cancer fund.

"There has been such great progress made in the fight against breast cancer," Kocher said. "All of these efforts keep moving us closer to finding a cure and saving more lives. I know that Badin and Fenwick are very pleased to be a part of the program."

The tripleheader starts with the freshman contest at 4:30 p.m. Admission is \$5 for adults wearing a 2009 Volley for the Cure t-shirt and free for students wearing the t-shirt. For those not wearing the t-shirt, admission is the regular price -- \$6 for adults and \$3 for students, with \$1 from each admission going to the cancer funds.

The 2009 Volley for the Cure t-shirts will be on sale at Badin all week during lunch as well as at the door for \$6 apiece, Kocher noted, and there will be basket raffles for \$1 each. In addition, the game officials have pledged their pay for the match to the cancer funds, and Tom Fritsch '58 will match the donations to his late wife's cancer assistance fund.

"We're always so gratified in the way people step up to make a difference," Kocher said. "This is yet another example of that, on a night that should make for some great volleyball as well."
