What is an Auction Sponsor?

An Auction Sponsor underwrites the cost of holding the event. As you can imagine, putting on an event like this takes money. You can help cover the cost of some of these items!

What are some examples of sponsorship?

You can cover the cost of most anything. You can sponsor the bar, the appetizers, desserts, a specialty drink, coffee bar, or an entire booth!

What are the benefits of being an Auction Sponsor?

Besides the benefit of helping Badin Students, as an Auction Sponsor, you will be recognized at the area in which you sponsor. For example, if you sponsor the bar you will have your name on a banner as the bar sponsor. Desserts and Appetizers signs will be in the lobby, and each booth that is sponsored will be recognized at that particular booth.

What does it cost to be an Auction Sponsor?

Your donation is up to you! The minimum amount for an Auction Sponsor sign is \$500.00. Some examples of what the Auction costs, here are some figures from last year:

Appetizers - \$1,000
Desserts - \$200
Bar - \$2,000 (total cost)
Booth Supplies - \$600
Postage - \$1,000
Printing - \$1,200
